SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Papers must be 2000-5000 words in length, excluding bibliography
- Papers should be attached to an email sent to u.g.phil.journal@sheffield.ac.uk - the body of the email should contain your name, study institution, year of study and paper title. Please not NO identifying information should be present on your paper.
- Papers which present a new approach to material or argue for an innovative or original claim will be given preference.
- All papers should be correctly referenced, though any style of referencing is permissible.
- Papers should be carefully checked for spelling and grammar errors.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- All papers are subject to review. This review process is double-blind with no identifying information of author or editor disclosed to anyone other than the Editor-In-Chief who will ensure all personal data is kept confidential until a decision has been made regarding acceptance.
- We will permit brief revision to be made prior to publication, based upon feedback from our editors, however regret we are not able to provide feedback on all submissions.
- Our initial edition, which will be published before the end of the summer semester will feature the work of Undergraduate students and interviews with Professor Jennifer Saul (University of Sheffield) and Professor Fiona Macpherson (University of Glasgow)
